#### **Getting to Bad Homburg**

#### By plane

For most of you, the easiest way to get to Bad Homburg is to take a plane to Frankfurt International Airport (FRA). From the airport you can take one of the local trains (S-8 or S-9) from the *Regionalbahnhof* to *Frankfurt Hauptbahnhof* (Frankfurt Central Station), where you can transfer to the S-5 train that will take you directly to Bad Homburg. The direction of the S-5 train should be either Friedrichsdorf or Bad Homburg.

Once you get off the plane and collect your luggage you will see signs that take you to the train station. Please make sure to take a local train (S-Bahn) out of the airport and not the Intercity Express (ICE).

You can purchase public transportation tickets directly at ticket machines at the station or online in the RMV-TicketShop.

The price for a one-way ticket from Frankfurt Regionalbahnhof (train station at the airport) to Bad Homburg is €6,30.

#### By train

The main train station, where the international trains arrive is located in Frankfurt (Frankfurt Hauptbahnhof). From there you can take the local train S-5 to Bad Homburg. The direction of the S-5 train should be either Friedrichsdorf or Bad Homburg. Railway can be a good alternative to air travel for members coming from neighbouring countries.

You can purchase public transportation tickets directly at ticket machines at the station or online in the RMV-TicketShop.

The price for a one-way ticket from Frankfurt Hauptbahnhof to Bad Homburg is €6,30. All information regarding the types of tickets, ticket machines, purchase options, fares information, etc. can be found here: <a href="https://www.rmv.de/c/en/tickets">https://www.rmv.de/c/en/tickets</a>

#### **Contribution**


Each delegate should pay a contribution to the host organisation (telc) as follows:
